



Plate Umpire Responsibilities

1. Call your partner the day/night before the game to verify their expected arrival time, cellular phone #, where to park, what type of vehicle they drive, etc. If a double-header, whoever had the plate on the 1st game is responsible to make the calls.
2. Call the school on game day to verify game info. Give AD/Coach both your contact name & phone # and your partner's and phone number.

***** Assessments *****

\$1-10 per game in accordance with the JUA Assessments Schedule Policy

Assessments are due on the day of the general membership meetings. There is a 5-day grace period. The JUA bylaws stipulate that the JUA Booking Commissioners cannot book you unless assessments have been paid, or other arrangements have been made. Please do not put yourself in this situation. You may call to see what assessments are owed.

Category 1. Schools - softball and baseball. . Each member who officiates contests that are Schools (FHSAA) recognized softball or baseball games shall pay assessments on a per game basis. These assessments shall either be deducted from the members games fees account or paid directly to the JUA Treasurer or Schools Division Booking Commissioner by each member according to the following schedule. The Treasurer shall hold Category 1 assessments on behalf of the members and pay the current Schools Booking Commissioner these monies monthly. Category 1 assessments are overdue 21 calendar days after becoming payable.
