Mercy Rules: 15 runs after 4 innings; 10 runs after 5 innings
Batting Order: Mandatory 10 players listed in the batting order with the additional player being listed as an “EP” that is free to float in and out on defense. This rule is to be waived if the total roster is 12 players or less.
Courtesy Runner: Mandatory for the pitcher and the catcher as soon as they reach base and play has stopped. Only the substitute players will be used for the courtesy runner unless there are no substitutes left on the lineup card, then, the last batted out would become the courtesy runner.
Intentional Walk: Do not need to pitch to the batter, simply notify the home plate umpire that the batter is to be intentionally walked and the batter will proceed immediately to 1st base.
